STERN disciplinary measures will be taken against the students in the Faculty of Commerce who organised and took part in a lectures

boycott.

In a strongly worded statement, the Registrar of University of Nairobi, Mr. M. K. Ndoria, said the authority strongly deplored and condemned the irresponsible and violent activities of certain student elements in the second year Faculty of Commerce which led to the disruption of lectures on the main and Chiromo campuses on Wednesday and Thursday.

"This small element was also responsible for considerable damage to University property as well as for assaults to a few fellow students and staff." the Registrar

said.

He said the alleged grievance that a student in her second year had been "demoted" to the first

year was utterly false.

The fact was that the student concerned had falled her examinations last year twice and she had been notified officially and within the faculty also last year that the University Senate had decided she should repeat the first year, Mr. Ndoria said.
