

Varsity receives German equipment

THE West German government yesterday gave the Nairobi University three portable tape-recorders and one overhead projector, all worth about 50,000/-.

The Charge d'Affaires of the German Embassy in Nairobi, Mr. Eberhard Noeldeke, presented the donation to the dean of the faculty of architecture, design and development, Prof. S. S. Yahya.

Also present at the function, which was held at the faculty of
