

Students to benefit from UoN and ZJNU partnership

The University of Nairobi (UoN) has entered into a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with Zhejiang Normal University (ZJNU), China to set up a students' exchange programme and develop short-term exchange courses. Under the terms of agreement, both parties will collaborate in the development of educational programmes and cultural exchanges based on favourable discussions and mutual benefits. The MoU will also lead to development of joint research projects and academic workshops, joint educational programmes and short-term seminars in specific fields and exchange academic information, educational and research materials and publications. There will also be staff exchange programmes and researchers.

Prof. Wu Fengmin, President, ZJNU, said that the partnership will be a new and exciting opportunity for students and members of staff from both Universities.
