

ABSTRACT

Linognathus samburi n. sp. is described from adult male and female specimens collected from a juvenile female Günther's dikdik (*Madoqua guentheri*) live-trapped near Olturot Village, Samburu district (Rift Valley Province) in northern Kenya. The new species is distinguished from other species of *Linognathus* including *L. geigy* and *L. damarensis* both of which parasitize Kirk's dikdik (*Madoqua kirkii*). A dichotomous key to the species of *Linognathus* that are known to parasitize dikdiks is included.
