Proposals generated from a food security research project involving twenty one counties were shared with chairpersons of agriculture committees in nineteen county governments. The proposals were informing policy and legal frameworks for increased food security in the country. The objectives of the workshop were: To disseminate the key research findings to the members of the County Assembly; To share and receive input on the food security proposals on policy and programmes and to share the draft legislative framework for the implementation of Article 43(1)(c). The workshop was attended by the Chairpersons of Agricultural Committees from 19 counties. These counties were West Pokot, Nyamira, Migori, Bomet, Bungoma, Kakamega, Siaya, Vihiga, Kiambu, Nyeri, Nyandarua, Machakos, Kitui, Kilifi, Nairobi, Isiolo, Marsabit, Murang'a and Makueni. The workshop was officially opened by the Principal of the college of Humanities and Social Sciences, Prof. Enos Njeru.

The Chairpersons of the agriculture committees from the various counties also shared their proposals on how best to make their counties food secure.
