Literature Department was honored by the visit of Mr. Oyeyinka on this date. He is a Nigerian writer who has had a rich growing up experience as he lived in three continents. He spent his first fifteen years in Nigeria, and the next ten years between Europe and USA. He obtained his first degree in Economics from Georgetown University, Washington DC in 2009. Thereafter he undertook a six month internship programme at the United Nations ILO in Ethiopia, before studying for a masters degree in Urbanization and Development at the London School of Economics. He is currently an assistant brand manager with Nigeria Breweries.

His first novel *Stillborn* is not only a tale of turmoil and tragedy; desperation and despair; but also one of optimism and opportunity.
