

Plagiarism software workshop held

The University of Nairobi recently identified a plagiarism software for use throughout the university. As a preliminary prior to formal launch, orientation workshops were held to enlighten chairs of various departments to its use.

A workshop for the College of health sciences was held on the 12th May 2015 at the medical school library led by a team from the main library.

During workshop chairs of respective departments were introduced to the software. They found it be very versatile and relatively easy to use. Most felt this would greatly help in reducing the scourge of plagiarism.
