Three Master of Arts students in the Department of Sociology and Social Work received scholarships from Cordaid. The three, Sarah Otieno, Caroline Jendeka and Raphael Ayapar who have successfully completed their coursework, were each awarded scholarships in the amount of Ksh. 300,000/= for research in Disaster Risk Reduction.
