

## CALL FOR INTERVIEW PANELLIST

## Tullow Group Scholarship Scheme (TGSS) 2015/16

The British Council has been managing the Tullow Group Scholarship Scheme on behalf of Tullow Oil PLC since 2011. The scheme aims to build capacity in areas where Tullow's host countries experience significant skills gaps, especially in the oil and gas industries. It is aligned with Tullow's aim of supporting long-term socio-economic development in countries where it operates.

Successful applicants will receive a scholarship to a leading UK university for a one year postgraduate degree programme.

To assist with the selection process the British Council welcomes applications from Academicians with a background in Oil and Gas, preferably Professors, Associate Professors or Senior lecturers with a PhD in relevant Engineering or Geology discipline. The specialist will be part of a panel that will conduct Final Interviews for the Tullow Group Scholarship Scheme (TGSS) 2015/2016.

These interviews will be held at the British Council offices in Upper Hill between 18<sup>th</sup> May and 4<sup>th</sup> June 2015. The commitment is a total of 12 working days in addition to a half day training session on 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2015.

## The panellist will be expected to:

- Evaluate the performance of candidates against set criteria during a face-to-face interview.
- Evaluate whether a candidate's professional and academic aspirations are aligned with their educational and work history and the scholarship objectives.
- Abide by British Council codes of confidentiality
- Must declare any conflict of interest (friend, family, friend of friend, family of friend and all acquaintances) with any applicant to a TGSS staff to have the application reassigned.
- Where necessary, recommend other assessment and attributes that will improve the selection process.

Kindly email your Curriculum Vitae and an expression of interest (500 words maximum) detailing why you would like to be considered and the skills and experience you would bring to this task.

This should reach us by midday on the 11<sup>th</sup> May 2015. Applications should be sent to <u>tullowscholarship@britishcouncil.or.ke</u> with Final Interview Panellist in the Subject Line.

We are often unable to respond to the large volume of applications received. If you do not hear from us by the 13<sup>th</sup> May 2015 kindly consider your application unsuccessful.
