The Ear Nose & Throat (ENT) Unit/Thematic area of the Department of Surgery runs some of the leading training programmes in ENT and Audiology in East and Central Africa. Alumni of its training programmes can be found in many African countries and it has positioned itself to play a leading role in the implementation of primary ear and hearing care by partnering with London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. One of the main research focus at the of the ENT Unit is treatment of the Discharging ear. The unit offers a diploma course in Clinical Audiology and Public Health Otology, the only such training programme aimed at training middle level audiology personnel in Africa.

One of the short courses offered is a one week Public Health

Planning for Hearing Impairment course which this year (2015) is being held from 23rd - 27th March. The course is offered in collaboration with the the <u>London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine (LSHTM)</u>.
