The objective of the workshop was to receive input and comments on the Department's Senate-approved courses and newly developed courses. Some of the proposed programmes that were presented and discussed include; Diploma in Disaster Management; Bachelor of Arts in Community Development and a Ph.D by Coursework and Dissertation.
