Minimum Admission Requirements

The common regulations governing admission into taught PhD programmes in all Institutes, Faculties, Schools and Centres of the University of Nairobi shall apply.

The following shall be eligible for admission:

1. A holder of a Master of Arts degree in Environmental Policy, Environmental Law or Environmental Diplomacy from the University of Nairobi or any other institution recognized by the Senate
2. A holder of a Masters Degree in environmental studies, law, humanities natural or social sciences or their equivalent from the University of Nairobi or any other institution recognized by the Senate.
3. A holder of a doctoral degree from any institution recognized by the Senate.
4. Other qualifications that may be considered acceptable to the Senate as equivalent to a Masters degree in relevant fields.

Application Procedure: Application forms can be obtained from the University of Nairobi Post graduate studies office at the Main Campus of the University, upon payment of a non-refundable application fee of Kshs 4,000. The application fee may be paid by Direct Deposit into the UNES/UON Account, Barclays Bank, Westlands Branch, A/C No. 03-073-1023948. CASH AND POSTAL ORDERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Application forms can also be downloaded from the University of Nairobi website: www.uonbi.ac.ke. Completed application forms with copies of certified degree certificates, transcripts, curriculum vitae and receipts of application fees attached should be returned to the Directors Office – CASELAP, University of Nairobi, Parklands Campus, Block B, P.O.
