ONLINE CONTENT DEVELOPMENT



The Department of Psychiatry is on course to have its Level I module on Behavioral Sciences be accessed online. To achieve this, the faculty members led by the Chairman Prof Mary Wangari Kuria, attended training on Online Content Management which took place at the **College of Health Sciences** (CHS) Library's IT Center on 27th August, 2015.

Among the areas the faculty was taken through are how to upload created content on the online portal, registering students for each module and units, and the assessment of individual student's and group's work. The content is expected to be uploaded very soon so that the program starts with the coming intake, and will go a long way in making the teaching, learning and assessment of the module more efficient.

This is the final phase of the Online Content Development scheme that the department has been working on for the last two years. The initial phases composed of creating the content and reviewing it, harmonizing the various sections of the modules, and familiarizing with the portal. All these were important so that the final work meets the specifications of the World Class University that the **University of Nairobi** really is.

This whole venture has been facilitated by Linked - Mental Health Research Training for Improved Health Outcomes in Kenya and the Partnership for Innovative Medical Education in Kenya (PRIME-K).

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
