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On 24th – 28th November 2014, CEBIB students attended a “Bioinformatics approaches for Next Generation Sequencing (NGS)” course hosted at the International Centre of

Insect Physiology and Ecology (ICIPE). The course was facilitated by TreND (Teaching and Research in Natural Sciences for Development in Africa) volunteers and comprised of participants from 20 different universities in 6 different African countries.

NGS analysis topics including de novo genome and transcriptome assembly, ChIP-seq and RNA-seq, rare variant calling and population genetics were taught. Other topics included introduction to R statistical programming language and software development concepts such as databases and version control.
