

## SAP Skills for Africa Graduates Second Cohort



63 students graduated with SAP skills on Wednesday, December 10, 2014 at its second graduation held in Chiromo Campus, University of Nairobi.

This is the second cohort of SAP graduands who have successfully undergone an eight week training on Financial Accounting and Business Intelligence. The training which was sponsored by ICT Authority and SAP East Africa, aims to increase sustainability and affordability of ICT skills for the economic growth of Africa. This it does by bridging the gap in present acute IT skills, noted in both government and not-for profit organizations. The course aims to train in communication, analytical and critical skills that tend to be deficient in most ICT graduates.

The first SAP graduation was held in 2013 in which 52 graduated. So far, graduates of the program have been absorbed in esteemed organizations such as TechnoBrain, BIDCO and Nation Media Group. Other organizations, such as CISCO, IBM, Microsoft and Oracle, were appealed to take part in training ICT skills.
