VC signs performance contract with management

As stipulated in the 12th cycle Performance Contract guidelines, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Peter Mbithi has signed performance contracts with the Deputy Vice-Chancellors and College Principals.

This is the first time Deputy Vice-Chancellors are signing the contracts.
