The Scholars Program provides young people from economically disadvantaged communities who have demonstrated academic talent and leadership potential with access to quality and relevant education.

The Program will serve an estimated 15,000 young people at the secondary and university levels. It has a particular focus on Africa, which is the world's youngest continent and is experiencing unprecedented growth. Yet, it faces the lowest secondary and university education enrollment rates.
