

Varsity towers 72 percent complete

The University of Nairobi Towers is at 72 percent complete. This was revealed during a brief on the Towers by the contractors to the University Management Board.

According to the China Wu Yi team, the ongoing finishing job is mainly cladding of the building, installation of electrical cables, and construction of the pavement, among others. The towers will be ready for use by the end of the year.

Upon completion, the Towers will accommodate the increasing academic activities and administrative services. The 21 floors with learning facilities will accommodate 3000 students and house facilities that include the Chandaria Centre for Performing Arts, Vice-Chancellor's Suite, Senate Boardroom, Council Meeting Room, one lecture theatre of 500 persons, four lecture theatres of 300 persons, and several lecture rooms to cater for a minimum of 60 persons, a floor for the Graduate School and a floor for the Graduate School of Business. It will also have a helipad.'

The team toured the Towers to assess the progress.
