Admission Requirements;
The common regulations for admission and registration in a master Degree in the University of Nairobi and the School of Economics shall apply.

In addition the following shall be eligible for admission to the Master Programme:

1. Holders of Bachelors degree at Upper second class Honours degree in Economics, Health Sciences or other related disciplines from an Institution recognized by Senate
2. Holders of Bachelor's degree at Lower Second class from an institution recognized by Senate, with at least 2 years relevant post qualification working experience
3. Holders of Pass degree from an Institution recognized by Senate and a relevant Postgraduate Diploma
4. Holders of Pass degree from an institution recognized by Senate, with at least five years relevant post qualification working experience

Application Procedure
Application forms can be obtained from the University of Nairobi Board of Postgraduate Studies upon payment of a non-refundable application fee of Kshs 3,000. (Note: Non-Kenyans pay 25% more on all charges). The application fee may be paid by Direct Deposit into the UNES/UON Account, Barclays Bank, Westlands Branch, A/C No. 03-073-1023948. CASH AND POSTAL ORDERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
