

wPOWER Hub at Wangari Maathai Institute Trains Women on Sustainable Clean Energy Entrepreneurship in Homabay from 21st to 23rd October 2015



Fifty five (55) participants, mostly women drawn from different women groups in Homabay County, undertook a three-day intensive training exercise on Sustainable clean energy entrepreneurship at Karachuonyo constituency.

The community training, organized by the wPOWER Hub at the Wangari Maathai Institute for Peace and Environmental Studies was meant to help capacitate grass-root women on their roles and responsibilities in securing a good future for themselves and their communities, through the adoption and usage of clean cooking and lighting technologies.

wPOWER Hub has conducted similar trainings in two other locations in Othaya and Muranga Counties. Both trainings have benefited a total of 101 trainees.
