Should like to point out that classification allocations up to date have been based on mode of procedure in India as nothing else to be guided as follows, transport, mechanical transport, supplies, clothing, ordnance, veterinary and remounts, medical services, printing office and stationery, marine, railway posts and telegraphe, army signals, military works, passages, rents, secret services and intelligence department, prisoner of war.
