With reference to Mr. Read's letter No. 48671/1915 of the 22nd instant, transmitting a copy of a telegram from the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate on the subject of accounting for military expenditure in East Africa, from which it appears that the accounts to the 31st March last will not be received in this office for a considerable time, I am commanded by the Army Council to acquaint you that the books of this office close at the end of November and that it is earnestly desired that the expenditure for the year 1914-15 may be included therein.

I am to request that you will cause a telegram in the following terms to be sent to the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate—

Your telegram 331 of 29th September. Cable total amount of audited Army expenditure to 31st March last, under various heads of service, or if these cannot be given under principal headings, urgent as books close at end of November. Cable when figures may be expected.
