Dear Read,

Thank you for your personal note of yesterday, re
mules for Belgian Congo Military Authorities. You are quite
correct in your recollection that other arrangements to obtain
the animals have been made. Twentyfour mules purchased by us
through our Agents in Cairo for the Belgian Authorities, are
now waiting at Port Said and will be shipped thence to Mombasa
in the s.s. "OLUNY CASTLE" due to leave Port Said during first
week of July. These are the animals which I wrote you of about
a fortnight ago, and you were then kind enough to let the East
African Authorities know so that the forwarding from Mombasa
to Uganda should be facilitated.

As a matter of fact, we have got hold of 20 more
mules in Egypt which the Belgian Authorities are now consider-
ing whether to buy or not but in any case, these could not go
forward by the August boat.
