DEAR SIR,

I have been asked by the Military Administration at G. G. for the telegraph battery at Entebbe to be supplied with 125 cases of ammunition as per schedule attached. The weights of packages, handling as a schedule, is attached.

They write that:-

"The 125 cases of wrapped each contain three smaller packages, each of the latter holding three chronicles. For purposes of portage across Uganda each of these main cases may be subdivided into the three component packages, for separate carriage, being thus within porter load limits. The 'Machine a refectionner' weighing 200 lbs. is packed in three pieces for portage. The 10 cases of shells, each weighing 55 kilograms each cannot be subdivided. The B.E.A. Messengers will be with Capt. Gayens and Mr. Mulligan, who are travelling in the 'Gazelle' by some destination as the ammunition, to give assistance in organizing the transport (including) of loads to..."

The weight of ammunition is 125 cases total. The weight will be 120 single porter loads and 20 double porter loads, total about 620 porters needed from Buk. Lake to Rutaburu inclusive of porters for the officers' baggage.

The stores to be sent at Mombasa 11th August. Perhaps the words of the above may kindly be copied per your office.

PARAPHRASE OF TELEGRAM. The Secretary of State
for the Colonies to the Governor of the East Africa
Protectorate.

(Sent 6.0.p.m. 12th August, 1915).

Agreeing that the proposed arrangement for the
East Africa Corporation Mombasa from Corporation
Mombasa to be operated by the British Auxiliary Administration
is not "desirable" (sic).

The proposed arrangement would require three
smaller vessels, each of the latter holding three
straps. For purposes of portage across Uganda
one of these main vessels would be utilized into
the inland waters of the lake, the smaller vessels
being used for the portage and return. The
arrangement proposed would also
require the use of a large number of
small boats for the portage of the cargo
of the main vessels.

The proposed arrangement would also require the
Governor and the Corporation to be established in
the "Colonies" for some destination as the arrangement
to give assistance in organizing the transport of
passengers or loads. (Ency.)
