field books and comput-
ations, relating to the
work in Lakshmi, and
that the Govt. is
to expedite the checking
of this work so that a
further payment on
account may be made
as soon as possible. It
will be observed that

the total balance remaining payable
to Mr. Beckman, subject to the
accuracy of his work, may be established
to be Rs. 4007.

4. As regards the Lakshmi
work also, the same is the Lakshmi
Lakshmi, and the Govt. reports that
in view of the reports that
the same referred to in the
earlier correspondence arose
from Mr. Beckman's having
taken a trigonometrical bearing
as being a boundary between
a farm. The correction, which
involved a re-survey of various
farm-subdivisions, has been
carried out departmentally at
a cost exceeding the sum of
Rs. 115 which remained due
to Mr. Beckman on this work.

(7) I would point out that Mr. Beckman has failed to lodge field notes and computations for a portion of his Laikipia work, consequently the department is unable to check that work.

Moreover, according to departmental regulations, Mr. Beckman is not entitled to any payments on account of those surveys until he lodges the field notes and computations. Up to date plans only have been lodged.

Mr. Beckman has been paid 60% on account for all his Laikipia surveys. The total disbursements showing an adverse balance of Rs. 622/78, due to the fact that he has been given payments for work for which he has lodged no data other than the plans; the value of such work being Rs. 5,487/19.

Provided these data are lodged, and the work passes the test satisfactorily, the balance due on all his surveys after deducting Rs. 685/69 for cement, beacons, etc., supplied by the Department, amounts to Rs. 4,007/74.

In the ordinary way Mr. Beckman would not have received any advance on the above until he lodged his field notes and computations, but owing to the hurried nature of his departure, and on the strength of letters (copies herewith) he was unfortunately given an advance, explained by statement above mentioned in para: (5). In these circumstances I cannot authorise any further payments to Mr. Beckman until the field notes and computations for the Laikipia Section of his work have been lodged.

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your above quoted letter, and the copies of despatches and enclosures to same referred to therein.

(2) I am now in a position to state the exact balance due to Mr. H.E. Beckman for work done under departmental instructions in Laikipia District.

(3) It has been necessary to completely revise the accounts presented. In some cases Mr. Beckman has under-stated the amounts due, and in others he has over-stated.

(4) His accounts generally bristle with clerical errors.

(5) I enclose copies of the revised accounts with copies of Mr. Beckman's accounts to show the various differences.

(6) The surveys effected by Mr. Beckman have been done in a very indifferent manner, and compare very unfavourably with that of most of the other surveyors.

a trigonometrical beacon which he made one of the corners of the farm in question, and by so doing caused considerable complications owing to the fact that the farm common to this beacon was sub-divided by the owner, thus necessitating a re-survey of the sub-divisions involved.

3. The correction was made departmentally, and the sum of Rs.115/-, being the balance due on the survey, did not cover the expenses of rectification.

4. I trust that there will be no need of further correspondence on this matter. The Director of Surveys was by no means impressed by Mr. Beckman's ability, and states that in many cases his demarcation was unsatisfactory and hastily done. He is also reported to be a difficult and troublesome man to deal with.

(7) I would point out that Mr. Beckman has failed to lodge field notes and computations for a portion of his Laikipia work, consequently the department is unable to check that work.

Moreover, according to departmental regulations, Mr. Beckman is not entitled to any payments on account of those surveys until he lodges the field notes and computations. Up to date plans only have been lodged.

Mr. Beckman has been paid 80% on account for all his Laikipia surveys. The total disbursements showing an adverse balance of Rs.822/12, due to the fact that he has been given payments for work for which he has lodged no data other than the plans; the value of such work being Rs.5,487/19.

Provided these data are lodged, and the work passes the test satisfactorily, the balance due on all his surveys after deducting Rs.655/69 for cement, beacons, etc., supplied by the Department, amounts to Rs.4,007/74.

In the ordinary way Mr. Beckman would not have received any advance on the above until he lodged his field notes and computations, but owing to the hurried nature of his departure, and on the strength of letters (copies herewith) he was unfortunately given an advance, explained by statement above mentioned in para: (5). In these circumstances I cannot authorise any further payments to Mr. Beckman until the field notes and computations for the Laikipia Section of his work have been lodged.

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your above quoted letter, and the copies of despatches and enclosures to same referred to therein.

(2) I am now in a position to state the exact balance due to Mr. N.E. Beckman for work done under departmental instructions in Laikipia District.

(3) It has been necessary to completely revise the accounts presented. In some cases Mr. Beckman has under-stated the amounts due, and in others he has over-stated.

(4) His accounts generally bristle with clerical errors.

(5) I enclose copies of the revised accounts with copies of Mr. Beckman's accounts to show the various differences.

(6) The surveys effected by Mr. Beckman have been done in a very indifferent manner, and compare very unfavourably with that of most of the other surveyors.



3. The correction was made departmentally, and the sum of Rs.115/-, being the balance due on the survey, did not cover the expenses of rectification.

4. I trust that there will be no need of further correspondence on this matter. The Director of Surveys was by no means impressed by Mr. Beckman's ability, and states that in many cases his demarcation was unsatisfactory and hastily done. He is also reported to be a difficult and troublesome man to deal with.
