Sir,

With reference to Mr. Harcourt's despatch No. 670 of the 19th of August 1913, I have the honour to inform you that 25 cases of enteric fever were reported as having occurred among the European residents in this Protectorate during the year 1914. Five of the cases proved fatal.

2. None of those affected had undergone preventive inoculation, but 70 Europeans, including officials and non-officials, were inoculated during the year.

3. The approximate total number of Europeans in the Protectorate was 4911. It is probable that the figures quoted for the years 1912 and 1913 were overestimated, but I have issued instructions for an annual return to be furnished which I hope will ensure greater accuracy in future.
