No. 46. Your telegram 16th February. Reply is in affirmative to all questions. Report received yesterday that person named has communicated through Government of Italian Somaliland to the effect that he is fully aware of the great crime which he has committed but was compelled by necessity and by Elliott's partiality adverse to law of white men. He is further reported to have asked for permission to send letter to the King in order to explain and justify his deportment. Further report received yesterday states that Aulihan are endeavouring to persuade Marehan and Mahomed Zubeir to join and that Abyssinian Aulihan will make attack upon Marehan if they do not join. Power is convinced that Abyssinian Aulihan are responsible for present position. Further that despatch letter arriving at Kismayu 13th February from Elliot states that Abyssinian Aulihan with assistance from Abyssinian troops threatened to make attack on Marehan and that if it occurred Marehan would join Abdul Rehman Marsaal. This might involve Mahomed Zubeir or Deshek Wama. Power reports despatch of troops to Jubaland necessary. Am endeavouring to arrange accordingly with the military authorities. Isaac reports from Lamu that the Aulihan and Mahomed Zubeir near Lorina are threatening Abd Way and Abdullas who are not strong enough to resist and may join in which case attack on coast town is to be feared. Distances and difficulties of communication render it extremely difficult to form any reliable appreciation of true position.

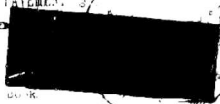
