Telegram from The Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

No. 126 Your telegram of 22nd April, estimates expenditure figures have been prepared with most scrupulous regard for economy and fullest appreciation of present conditions. No figures have been inserted which cannot be justified, and while accepting with reluctance certain reductions directed by you, I must press for retention of others, omission of which would be detrimental to public interests. Head xii my despatch of 4th February last year, ^{No. 17} paragraph 12, items 10, 17 and 18 should remain unaltered. New appointments 9 to relieve Commissioners of detail work of lower grades. New appointment 10 required for Criminal Investigation Department. Item 14, increased rate should stand, omitting new appointment. Refusal to grant these increases would cause grave general dissatisfaction and consequent loss of efficiency with risk of resignation. Items 22, 23 and 24, one appointment in each class should remain. Urgently necessary to provide for supervision of new stations. Head xiii, Items 12 and 15, these increases are essential to ensure continued satisfactory service, refusal would cause serious discontent and they should be retained. I can omit items 27, 28 and 30 if item 29 is retained. I must press for this as it represents smallest additional staff with which it will be possible to supervise all prisoners. Corresponding reduction will be made under other charges. Request that you will reconsider above items in view of my personal assurance of their necessity and advise me of your conclusions by telegram.

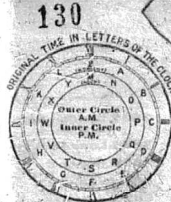
