ESCURR OF WAR DIARY from 26th August 1916 to 8th September 1916 (incl.)

20th August. Lake Detachment. - G.O.C. reports our troops at
Malero waiting for the Belgian troops to reach St. Michael
before continuing a combined advance.

lst. & 3rd. Divisions - Sheppard's Brigage ordered : -- ove along the left bank of Egerengere River towards Mohoro. 2nd. Mounted Brigade is in the vicinity of Miahi.

2nd Bivision - Ist Mounted Brigade reached Misli.

One mounted regiment engaged the enemy on the 25th inst. at Uleia and drove him South. Our pasualties, two killed and four wounded.

2"th August. Lake Detachment. - No change in the situation.

lst & 3rd Divisions. - The 2nd Mounted Brigade is engaged with the enemy near Mlali.

Hannyngton's Brigade is proceeding to occupy Mikesee Station east of Morogoro.

Sheppard's and Beves' Brigades occupied Morogoro in the evening of the 2nd inst.

2nd Division. - 1st Mounted drigade has driven the sneme of White, and are retiging in the simplification of Whitehearts

Nyasaland Force. - General Northey occupied Linguish and Wuassar on the 23rd inst.

28th August. Lake Detachment. - Successful patrol actions on the 21st inst. at Ilola and Schanoa resulted in the capture of two whites; enemy's casualties, two whites and eight askaris killed Our casualties insignificant.

1st & 3rd Divisions. - No change reported.

2nd Division. - Two battalions of infantry have been despatched from Kilosse to Kidatu, at which place the Ruaha River is crossed.

The mounted troops are still engaged with the enemy's rearguard south of Uleia.
