TOMORROW

From General Staff - Smyrna - 1915 - Imperial General Staff.

11th May 1915 11.30 p.m.

... enemy in front of the Hind Division at Kondoa Irang
city during the last 2 days and pushed back our patrols toward
Kondoa. This could not be maintained owing to dense bush, and was abandoned.
On 9th May they began to shell Kondoa with heavy artillery and in the
afternoon started a determined attack which was not finally beaten off before 2 a.m.
There were 6 killed and 19 wounded. The men were carried away and some
were buried, but next morning the dead were found round our position. At 11.30 a.m.
Lieutenant-Colonel von Schach, the German Commandant, who is personally in command, before
the arrival of his reinforcements, is reported to be waiting for reinforcements on the arrival of which opera-
tions will be renewed. I am pushing my patrols forward to the Hind Di-
vision as the result of stores landed at Soudi Bay, the enemy. A saggis in this night
was found to be armed with new rifles and ammunition and equipped with new
rifles. European manufacture issued recently at Tripoli. A new gun, apparently
not previously used, besides field and naval guns.
