With reference to your despatch No. 335 dated the 30th April 1917, I have the honour to inform you that Messrs. Mackinnon Mackenzie and Company, the Agents in India report that it is now impossible to engage Assistant Surgeons on an initial salary of Rs. 250/- per mensem.

The maximum pay to which Assistant Surgeons can rise under the rules for their employment sanctioned in Mr. Harcourt's despatch No. 708 dated the 28th August 1913 is Rs. 300/- per mensem and, in view of the desirability of obtaining them at once if possible, I have, subject to confirmation by you, approved of a salary of Rs. 300/- per mensem being offered if necessary.

I trust that this procedure will meet with your approval.
