

The most important matter with which these regulations deal is the control of prices of foodstuffs which for the most part are imported from India. Arrangements have been made whereby supplies are brought to us by a steamer every month and, though this device has hitherto worked smoothly, there is practically no surplus supply of essential commodities such as flour, sugar, rice, and certain other Indian articles of diet, and any failure of shipping facilities or diminutio of imports would cause an immediate shortage.
