With reference to your letter No. 61866/1916., of the 3rd instant, forwarding a copy of a despatch from the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, I am commanded to inform you that as according to the copy of the despatch forwarded with Colonial Office letter No. 11902/1915, of the 1st May, 1915, the military operations against the Merehan Tribe were confined to the troops which operated north of Serenli, under the late Lieutenant Colonel B.R. Graham, King's African Rifles, the Army Council consider that the award of the medal should be confined to those employed in and north of that town between the 15th December, 1913, and the 31st May, 1914.
