With reference to your letter 10963 1/2, (F.3) of the 21st April, relative to an application for further compensation for Mr. W.R. Nesfield, late Loyal North Lancashire Regiment and formerly a Trooper Bast African Mounted Rifles, I am directed by the Minister of Pensions to inform you that in the opinion of the Medical Board by whom Mr. Nesfield was examined he is incapacitated to the extent of one-half. The case has been schmitted to the Chief Medical Adviser to the Ministry and after considering the whole of the facts submitted, he geneurs in the opinion of the Medical Board as regards the degree of incapacity.

If Mr. Nesfield had been serving in the British Army at the time he received its wound he would now be eligible, under the provisions of the 1917 Warrant, to a conditional pension of 13/9d a week
