Reports received from Turkana Land during the past fortnight are not such as to warrant the usual summary.

The Abyscians reported on the Nalialale river, vide penultimate paragraph of the last summary, are now said to have numbered twenty and to have been engaged in collecting hut tax and not in selling rifles.

Major Rayne is expected in Nairobi in a few days time, when a conference on the Turkana situation will take place.
