1113 July 13th At request of Indian
Association Nairobi I transmit following message
begins My Association supports strongly Mombasa
Association representation regarding sale of reser-
vational plots there. Endorses statements contained
therein. Humble prayer that local Govern-
ment to refrain from imposing restriction of
land sales and from enforcing principle of
segregation races. Most humble submission that
highly controversial matters such as above
should be kept in abeyance ~~until the end of war~~
Fact existence of martial law ~~ought not to~~
be forgotten. Reference local Government telegram
6/2 192 February 14th received no further reply.
Since then Government imposed surcharge tax.
Applied conscription to Indians. Yet no Indian
members on War Council. Appointed Civil Service
Commission

Commission without Indian members. Immediate appointment of Indian members on Legislative Council and War Council absolutely necessary to safeguard Indian interests. Absence Indian members seriously prejudices interests of Indians. Most respectful prayer to obtain His Majesty's sanction and to issue necessary instructions to Government to appoint at least two members to be recommended by Nairobi and Mombasa Indian Associations. These seats quite independent of contemplated self-Government scheme signed Hussainbhai Suleman Virji President Indian Association Nairobi also representing Indian Association at Mombasa Nakuru Kisumu and Machakos message ends Association ask that message should be repeated to Secretary of State for India.
