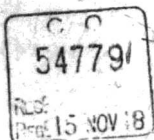


Sir,

I have the honour to report ~~cross~~ in accordance with Section 7(1) of the Royal Pensions Warrant 1918, I have granted to Mr. H.I. Lovegrove, who served in the East Africa Regiment as a Private for 11 months in 1914-15 and for a further 11 months in the East Africa Pioneers in 1917-18, a gratuity of £40. He was discharged medically unfit on 16th March 1918, after a Medical Board which found him suffering from chronic Bright's disease, and incapacitated 50 per cent. The disability was contracted in, but not caused by nor aggravated by military service nor by his own fault.
