We are acting for the Vacuum Oil Company, Limited, and are informed that their late employee, Diechmann, was, on the application of the Russian Foreign Office, arrested in Mombasa a short while ago under the name of White. We understand that, with the dossier, has been forwarded a photograph of Diechmann, which the Russian Embassy requests shall be regarded as sufficient evidence of identification. In order to avoid delay, would you be good enough to cause an enquiry to be cabled to the proper official enquiring whether the legal Court will accept that photograph as evidence of identification, or whether the attendance of some one who can prove Diechmann's identity with the person arrested will be requisite?

Our Clients would also like to know whether any and what money or securities have been found with the arrested person, and would be obliged if you would also cause an enquiry as to this.

Please take this letter as our undertaking to bear the expense of the necessary cables. It is desirable that we should be informed of the replies thereto as early as possible, and we shall be obliged if you will if you will direct attention to be given to this *without delay*.
