Your telegram to Sanitary Commissioner Madras regarding your services for British East Africa. Please communicate direct with Government of India Political Department, Simla in the matter. Madras Local".

Copy of telegram received from the Sanitary Commissioner, Madras dated 2nd July 1919.

Cochin Madras S-I State Dr. Palpa Empire Hindu Hotel, Bombay,

Your letter 28th June. Madras Special Office enquire whether and on what terms your services can be engaged temporarily for British East Africa in connection with vaccination. Please also say whether two Indian Assistants can be obtained by you and on what terms. Kindly reply urgently. Sanitary, Madras".

Copy of reply to Sanitary Commissioner, Madras, dated 2nd July 1919. with copy of letter referred to.

Sanitary-Madras.

Thanks for telegram. Special circumstances necessitated pay two thousand and full facilities. Study and due recognition of past work essential. Shall try to secure two qualified medical assistants within 1500 or thereabout and two trained vaccinators within 150. Total within 3500 monthly exclusive clerical and menial staff required there. Official requisition necessary for loan of services in some cases. Letter follows. Palpa".

6. In regard to the assistants required, it will be seen that they have to be selected with special care, for experience has shown that the professional or other qualifications will not be enough, and that the nature of the work is such that it can be satisfactorily and successfully done only by those who have an interest in the special line, and the necessary patience required. The officers I have in view are those in Service in the State referred to above, and have had some experience in connection with the work.

7. The number of assistants required in my Division is rather small, and so it is likely that they may not be necessary in proportion to the amount of work to be done, but they may be able to do excellent work by their own initiative.

8. It is hoped that the services of several staff assistants will be available in next session.
