With reference to your letter of the  
ultimo No. 24338/1919, transmitting copy of  
letter from Mrs. Burgess, applying for a bonus  
20% on her pension, I am directed by the  
Minister of Pensions to state for the information  
of Viscount Milner that it has been decided that  
payment of the 20% War Bonus on pensions shall be  
extended to the case of disabled men and widows  
in receipt of Alternative Pensions.

The Bonus will be granted, so far as  
Alternative Pensions are concerned with effect from  
the 1st January 1919, and will be continued up to  
the 30th of September next. Had Mrs. Burgess been in  
receipt of an Alternative Pension under Article 13  
of the Royal Warrant, the bonus with any arrears  
due would have been paid to her forthwith.
