In reply to your letter 28766/1919 of the 21st ultimo, I am directed by the Minister of Pensions to acquaint you, for the information of the Secretary of State that, had Lieutenant J.R. Watcham, West African Labour Corps, served in the British Army, temporary retired pay would have been awarded to him at the rate of £52.10.0. a year from 13th August, 1916 to 17th July, 1919, when he would be at liberty to apply for a medical examination with a view to the further consideration of his case.
