So expedite settlement I am prepared, on valid authority from the Colonial Office, to pay all monies due to you to the credit of your account with the Standard Bank of S. Africa Ltd, Nairobi. You received your commission on 22/12/1918 and relinquished same on 16/5/1919 and are therefore entitled to 310 days gratuity at 13/6d a day - £209 - 5 - 0 (Rs 3128.75). You are entitled to Bonus from 1/10/1917 to 16/11/18 (date of embarkation for England) - 13 28 months @ 25 per month if single or 25 per month if married or a widower with children.
