has been under treatment at St Bartholomew's Hospital and has not received pension etc.

Mr Reborn apparently commenced payment for the L.W.P. Grade in £2.50 (17/6/91 £0) and not on the 1st as stated in his letter of 1st March (14/9/91 £0). This makes him entitled to the day's money from 1st at the rate of £1.15 p.w. week. It was paid by the Committee of £2.50 (incl) and he started work on the 2nd of March (with this paper) so that on that day he should go back

on the £1.15 rate. Mr Reborn would therefore refer to C.A. the diff between one day's pension at £3.50 p.w. and £1.15 p.w. and a 21 minutes difference with £5.00 (17/6/91 £0) copy of his re-born letter of 3rd April and ask them to determine what rate he should receive an alternative pension and for what period at that rate. Ask whether there are any other charges other than those mentioned in their letter of 20th March (17/6/91 £0) and say that for 17/6/91 all branches.
