I have the honour to inform well that I proceeded to B. E. Africa on August 23rd, 1911, as an Assistant Engineer, Public Works Department, under an agreement with the Grown Agents for the Colonies, and have the honour to report my arrival in England on 17th ultimo.

On December 27th, 1913, I was informed that correspondence had been passing between the Secretariat, fairobi, and the Secretary of State relating to over-expenditure on certain Government buildings under my control, and that the Director of Public Works had suggested withhelding the privilege of leave pay, subsequent to the termination of my work, and had not recommended my centimued retention in the Department. On this I applied to His Excellency the Governor for a Board of Inquiry, which he was pleased to grant. The finding of this Board has not yet been conveyed to me officially but as I believe the finding to have been in my favour,
