Your cypher telegram of January 30th please communicate following telegram to British East African Corporation London. Begins. "Instructions have been given to Webster, Corporation Manager at Masindi, to proceed Managi immediately and there receive from Monsieur Braine, Director-General of Kale Mine £64,000 bar gold, weight 1,100 lbs. and thence accompany same to Jinja from where same will be accompanied by other European officer". End of telegram.
