May I proceed with excavation of tank in anticipation of sanction in Estimates 1915-16. Jirama labour now offering which is very undesirable to refuse.

To: Col. G. Fiddes.

If the proposal is to be approved at all it is well worth while to anticipate it by three weeks or less in order to keep the Jirama quiet.

As regards 48377/4 - it contained two proposals for expenditure over & above the £90,000 allotted for this work ~~from~~ to £250,000 loan. The distribution of the £90,000 is shown on p. 113 of the draft 1915-16 Estimates.

(a). Distribution, which appears at £14,220 in the loan table, is to cost £23,800, and approval was sought for the difference of £9,600.
