I am informed by General Officer Commanding that it is necessary for tactical casons to withdraw from Longido to Bissil. I have no wish to interfere with a military measure of the propriety of which I am satisfied, but it is my duty to inform year that the result may be that a large body of the Massi, who have most loyally aided our operations, will be deprived of the protection which they have the right to expect, and that they will be left with their cattle exposed to enemy raids in these parts which are not protected by our patrols since to remove whole of them behind the lines of retirement is not practicable. This may most seriously afters our @ prestige and may be considered by the Massi tayin sot of desertion, the reason for which will not be to thom apparent.
