BRITISH EAST AFRIC

April 12th 1915.

Sir.

I have the henour to recommend that the Officer-in-Charge, Masai Reserve, and the Officerin-Charge, Northern Frontier District, should draw travelling allowances equivalent to those of Provincial Commissioners viz: at the rate of Rs. 7.50 per diem.

- The officers selected for these two posts are required to spend a large part of their time in travelling and as their obligations are no less than those of Provincial Commissioners I consider that it is only fair that they should receive travelling allowance on the same scale.
- I trust that you will be able to accord sanction to this.
