In his letter of 25 January last (11015), the

the Central School, Eldoret in July, 1915.

In request last (36062) the Govt recommended
their re-appointment to the staff of the Nairobi "A"
School and Mr Humphries was appointed Asst.
Master (£200-£250) and Mrs Humphries Head-
mistress (£100).

They are applying to transfer to the Eldoret School.
This will mean a decrease of salary but a
more independent position for Mr Humphries.
