

There are at present five vacancies for Assistant District Commissioners in the East Africa Protectorate and a despatch which has just been received from the Governor (see 28462/15) indicates that the matter is urgent. There is great difficulty at the present time in finding able-bodied candidates who come up to the standard which has been reached in the last few years for candidates for Administrative appointments in the East African Colonies.

For one of these vacancies, however, I am able to submit :-

MR. CHARLES TOMKINSON, who is resident in East Africa and to whom Mr. Harcourt offered the post of Assistant District Commissioner in Lamibar in April last. Mr. Tomkinson refused this post, and perhaps it was only natural as his belongings and interest are in East Africa. He appears to be in every way fitted for Colonial employment, and after talking to the Department I submit him to you.
